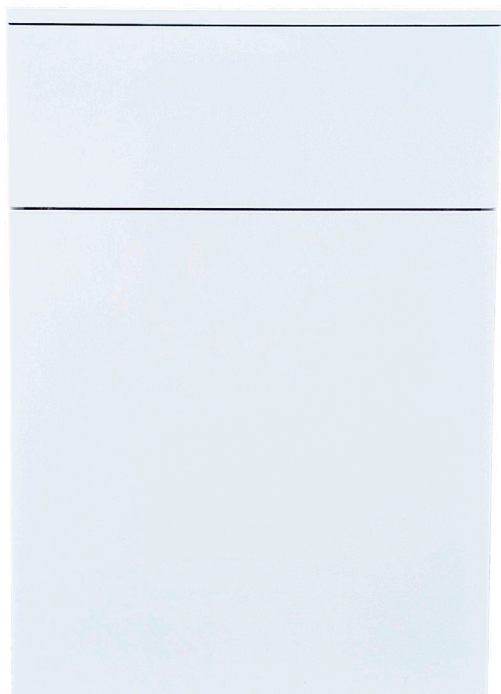

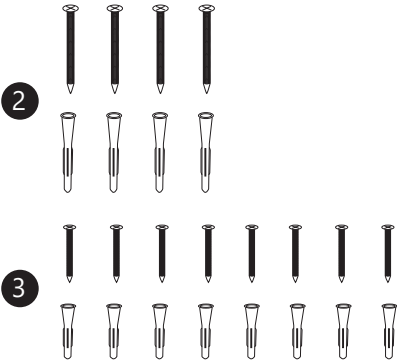
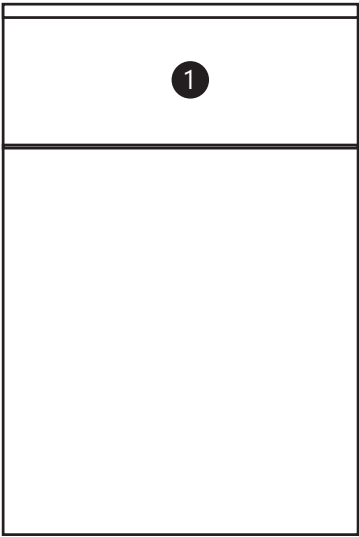

Before starting installation

Whilst these products are made to a high standard, please take every care when handling them to avoid surface damage.

Please remove all packaging and make sure no components are missing. The following components should be present:

ITEM	DESCRIPTION
1	Furniture unit
2	Large screws and rawl plugs x 4
3	Small screws and rawl plugs x 8



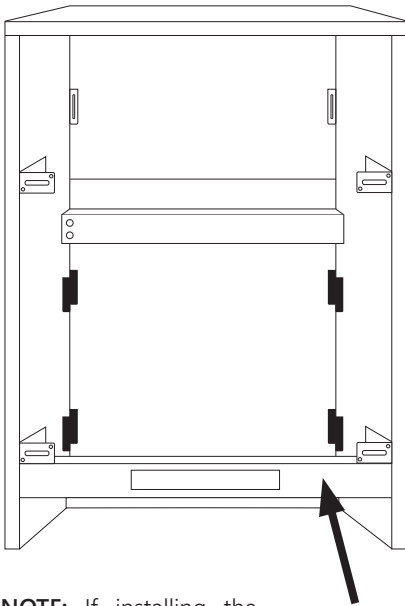
Installation

Before drilling any holes, please make sure you are aware of the location of electric wires and other pipes that may sit in or behind the wall.

It is recommended to install to a solid wall, but if fitting to a stud wall, the fixings must be secured into a stud, not only into the plasterboard.

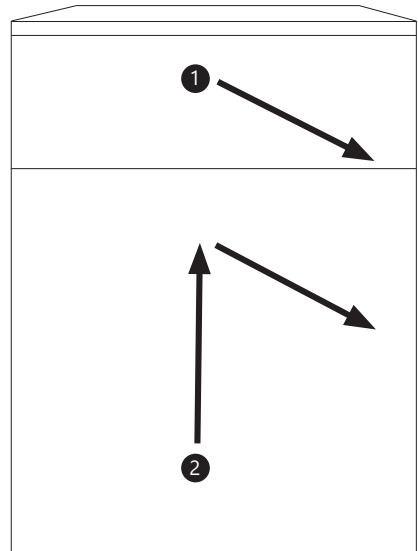
1. Please ensure that your chosen cistern is fitted to the wall before installing this furniture unit.

2. Remove the front panels from the furniture unit.

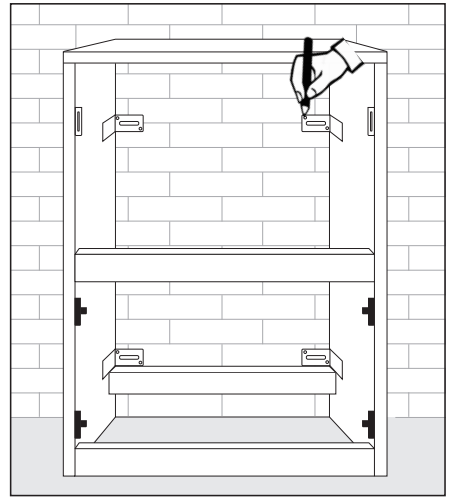


Bottom strut

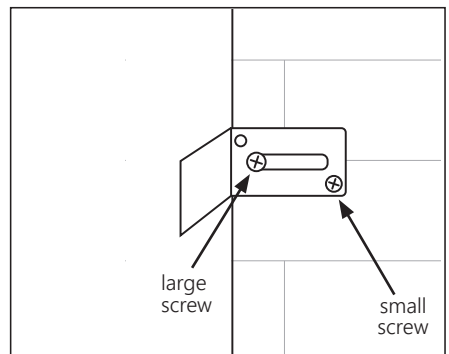
NOTE: If installing the unit with a framed cistern, the bottom strut may need to be removed and discarded



3. Offer the unit up to the wall and mark the holes where the unit will be fixed to the wall.



4. Drill holes in the screw positions.
5. Fit the unit to the wall using the rawl plugs and screws provided. Use at least 2 screws on each bracket, selecting the smaller screws for the round hole and the larger screws for the oval adjustable fixing slot.
6. Template and cut holes in the front panels for WC pipework and flush buttons.
7. Re-fit the front panels to the furniture unit.
