
## Before starting installation

These products are made from plated brass, so please take every care when handling them to avoid surface damage.

Please remove all packaging, and make sure no components are missing. The following components should be present:


### Vaere, Oculus, Maze & Lantic:

### Latitude

Do not dismantle the product. The cartridge has been calibrated and tested and must not be tampered with prior to installation.


Before installation, please ensure that the plumbing system has been fully flushed to remove dirt and debris.

We recommend water inlet pressures of 0.2 to 5 bar.

## Installation Instructions


1. This product requires adequately balanced hot and cold water supplies.
2. Turn off water supply.
3. Calculate how deeply the body should be set into the wall using the depth tolerances in the table below. Remember to allow for the thickness of finished wall surfaces and decoration (plasterboard, adhesive, tiles etc.)

Oculus & Maze:




4. On the installation wall, mark the 4 drill holes that correspond to the holes on the body and drill the holes.
5. Insert the rawlplugs and then screw the body into the wall with the 4 screws provided.




6. Connect the body to your water supply, making sure the hot water is fed to the bottom inlet, and the cold from the side.





7. These products come fitted with 2 plastic protective covers to allow the body to be fitted before any tiling or painting of the bathroom takes place. Please remove these once any decoration is complete and you are ready to add the spout and handle.
8. Slide on the spout cover plate and then push the spout onto the water outlet. Secure the spout in position by tightening the grub screws.
9. Secure the spout in position with the two M5 grub screws.



10. Slide on the handle cover plate then attach the handle and secure it in position by tightening the grub screws.



11. Lift the lever towards you operate and control the flow. Turn the lever left for hotter water and right for colder.
